CHANGES "KEY"	
BLK	Full, three-digit page number area of map
OLD	The old (now changed) parcel number
NEW	The new (now changed) parcel number
YR	Assessed tax year the change took place
CUT	Refers to the Assessor's file for document number regarding the change

- 1 Tax Map Key
- 2 Parcel Number
- 3 Lot Number
- 4 Area of Lot
- 5 Approximate dimensions in Feet
- 6 Lot line (solid line)
- 7 Easement and Setback lines (dotted line)
- 8 Owner name as of the date of the map
- 9 Compass Indicator
- 10 Dropped parcel – indicates parcel has been canceled due to dedication to roadway.
- 11 Location of area
- 12 Plat Map number of neighboring area
